CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION AS AT 2018 A.G.M.

1. ORDER OF EVENTS The programme shall be as follows

- 1.1. All events shall be swum under A.S.A Laws and Regulations, and A.S.A. Technical Rules of Swimming
- 1.2. Conforming to The National Arena Swimming League constitution.

1.3. The team coach or chaperone may escort a swimmer to the start but must withdraw as soon as the swimmers come under the referees control.

1.4. No club official shall be allowed at the end of the pool without specific authority of the referee.

2. POINTS SYSTEM AND SCORING

2.1. Points scoring at galas for 6 teams:- 6,5,4,3,2 1. Points scoring at galas for 5 teams:- 5,4,3,2,1.

2.2. Points scoring for League tables for 30, 24, 18, teams:-

2.2.1.Round One. 6,5,4,3,2 1.

2.2.2.Round Two. 6,5,4,3,2,1. As round one, plus a bonus of 10 points for teams who swim in the top gala of round three.

2.2.3.Round Three:- top gala only. 12,10,8,6,4,2. All other galas score as round one but NO bonus points.

3. NUMBER OF SWIMS PER SWIMMER.

3.1. Swimmers 16 years and over who are eligible to swim in the open event may swim three individual events.

3.2. Swimmers 15 years, 13 years, 11 years and under may swim in three individual events with a maximum of two events in their own age group and a maximum of one event in any age group above.

3.3. There are no restrictions in relay events, but you cannot swim below your age group

3.4. In the event of an infringement of 3.1 or 3.2 the team shall have all points gained by that deemed disqualified swimmer in that event deducted from the team's total gala points, plus 10 gala points deducted for each offence.

4. COMPOSITION OF THE LEAGUE.

- 4.1. Premier Division and Division Two shall consist of 24 teams, the remaining teams shall be Division Three
- 4.2. Promotion and Relegation between Divisions Premier and Two shall be four teams. Four teams will be promoted from Division Three.
- 4.3. Where a club has 2 or more teams in the league no swimmer from a higher rated team shall swim in the promotional finals for a lower rated team unless that swimmer has within the same season competed as a member of the lower rated team. These four relegated teams shall then be placed at the bottom of the division they are being relegated to. In the event of there being a re-organisation of the divisions the promotion and relegation shall be effected before that re-organisation takes place.

5. DRAW

5.1. The League shall run as follows for:- 20 & 24 Teams.

- 5.1.1. ROUND ONE The draw to be made at the A.G.M. between the teams to divide them into four groups of 5 or 6 for the four galas to be swum on the first night, (the Officers to make the draw for the first round.)
- 5.1.2. ROUND TWO The gala points gained in the four galas of round one are used to decide the four galas of round two in the following manner:-
 - 5.1.2.1. Gala 1. The team with the highest number of points plus the teams with the 5th, 9th, 13th, 17th and (21st)
 - 5.1.2.2. Gala 2. The team with the second highest number of points plus the teams with the 6th, 10th, 14th, 18th and (22nd)
 - 5.1.2.3. Gala 3. The team with the third highest number of points plus the teams with the 7th, 11th, 15th, 19th, and (23rd)
 - 5.1.2.4. Gala 4. The team with the fourth highest number of points plus the teams with the 8th, 12th, 16th, 20th, and (24th)
 - 5.1.2.5. The remaining teams participating in round one.
 - 5.1.2.6. ROUND TWO ALL GALAS WILL BE SPEARHEADED.

5.1.3. ROUND THREE

- 5.1.3.1. When 24 teams are competing, teams who were 1st in 2nd round gala. Plus 2 teams with highest gala points from rounds 1 & 2
- 5.1.3.2. Gala 2. Next 6 to gain the highest number of points in the galas of round one and two.
- 5.1.3.3. Gala 3. Next 6 to gain the highest number of points in the galas of round one and two..
- 5.1.3.4. Gala 4. The remaining teams competing in round two
- 5.1.3.5. ROUND THREE ALL GALAS WILL BE SPEARHEADED.
- 5.1.3.6. The four teams to be relegated (from Premier and Division Two) shall be the four teams in positions 21,22,23,&24 in a 24 team division.

6. COLLATION OF GALA RESULTS.

- 6.1. The delegate or appointed deputy of the hosting club shall email the result sheet to the appointed person on Saturday evening following the gala.
- 6.2. The Secretary or appointed person shall notify the teams of their next venue at least 14 days before the next gala date. All teams to be informed by the Secretary of all results of every gala, as well as the League table positions after each round by posting all results and league tables on the National website.
 - 6.2.1. When only two rounds of the competition can be completed:-

- 6.2.1.1. The results after these two rounds shall be declared the final results for that year's competition and presentations, promotions and relegations shall be made accordingly except for the finalists of premier division .
- 6.2.1.2. The top six teams of Premier division shall compete in order to complete the league table and determine the clubs to represent The National Swimming League West Midlands in The National Swimming League Cup Finals.

7. PLACINGS.

- 7.1. In the case of a dead heat in a race, both teams will receive the same points for the place they achieved. (e.g. if lanes 3 and 5 dead heat for 1st place in a six team gala, both should receive 6 points, and the third place 4 points as usual. The points should not be averaged i.e. both receiving 5½
- 7.2. To determine placings if teams tie on either gala points or league points:-
 - 7.2.1. ROUND ONE The number of first places will be taken into account, then if necessary the number of second places and so on.
 - 7.2.2. ROUND TWO The number of first places will be taken into account, then if necessary the number of second places and so on if two teams swimming in the same gala have equal points in that gala to determine the order of the result for that gala. If teams swimming in different galas have equal league points then the total number of gala points from galas 1 and 2 will determine placings.
 - 7.2.3. ROUND THREE The total number of gala points from galas 1, 2 and 3 will determine placings. In all cases, if there is a tie on total gala points, the number of first places will be taken into account, then if necessary the number of second places and so on.
